**Assembly Area:** Large dirt lot on Main St. between Wall & Vine. Entries will enter at Butler & Main St. Please do not trespass on the Coliseum property. Please wait in the big dirty lot staging area until line up begins, (keep in mind all military related participants will be lined up first). Please come as decorated as possible. Last minute decorations will

be fine but there is not room or time for the floats to be completely decorated on site.

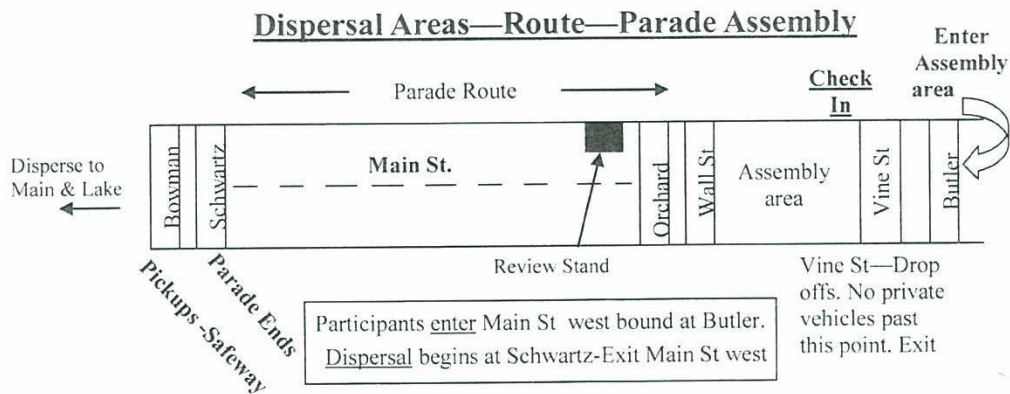
**Line Up: Participants must be at the parade staging area at Butler & Main St. by 7:30PM.** Drop off can be made, but vehicles must exit on Vine St. If you have several vehicles in your entry please arrive at the line-up area at the same time. Late entries will not be allowed to participate in the parade. Vehicles not registered for the parade will **NOT** be allowed in the assembly area. (See map)

**Theme:** All parade participants must use the parade theme. Please identify your entry with large signs on both sides for the public to see and the judges to see at the review stand, who will be deciding theme/category winners.

**Non-Judged Category:** Princesses and Queens **will not** be judged.

**Bio:** Please include a one paragraph description (bio) of your entry with your entry form. This will be used for announcer broadcasting purposes during the parade.
